It is elasticated at the wrist for comfort and the fingerless design protects the palm and back of hand. The sleeves are seamless, very light and flexible. Additionally, the Oxford sleeve offers a high degree of dexterity and comfort. Moreover, it possesses good heat protection properties that are ideal when working with hot products, particularly contact heat.

Material - Protecta is a grey coloured multi-fibre thread based on the new Tsunooga® cut resistant fibres, made by TOYOBO in Japan. These Protecta fibres, enrobe the fibre glass fibres. This wrap avoids the fibreglass fibres coming in contact with the skin of the user which could cause an allergic reaction or itching.
